

Hello KentuckyView Members – (if you are not yet a Member, please contact me to join)

I am writing to let you know about some exciting opportunities to apply for [KentuckyView](#) funding of educational, outreach, applied research and data distribution activities that focus on, but do not have to be exclusively about, remote sensing.

Eligible expenses: faculty/staff stipends, student wages, software, data, in-state travel, supplies, etc.

Note: Activities need to have already occurred or be planned and carried out during the period September 30, 2008 – November 30, 2009.

OPPORTUNITIES

Starting immediately, faculty and staff at Member institutions are eligible to apply for funding in one or more of the following mini-grant categories:

(A) STIPENDS – for proposed OR already completed activities (awards of \$200-\$500)

1) Presentations/Activities/Demonstrations

- i. For presenting lectures and/or demonstrations to the general public
- ii. For presenting activities/lectures/demonstrations targeting youth organizations (e.g., 4H, FFH)
- iii. ***For presenting activities/lectures/demonstrations in K-16 classrooms.***
- iv. For presenting a session at a K-12 teacher education workshop
(Please apply for a Project award to request more substantial funding for upcoming workshops.)
- v. For presenting the KentuckyView program to users groups or geospatial consortia or at state, regional or national meetings

2) Publications

- i. For having relevant materials published in local/regional/state media outlets.
- ii. For having relevant articles published in 'grey' or 'trade' journals.

3) Other

- i. For developing web-based tutorials or lesson plans.
- ii. ***For purchasing supplies in support of geospatial teaching or outreach (e.g., maps, data, etc.).***
- iii. For developing FAQs or other 'how to' materials.

(B) PROJECTS – for proposed activities ONLY

(awards of up to \$1000)

1) Applied Research

- i. For developing innovative uses for moderate resolution satellite data (e.g., Landsat), apart from routine mapping applications
- ii. For applied remote sensing research projects in Kentucky

2) Education

- i. For providing K-12 teacher education workshops ***or similar activities***

3) Data Distribution

- i. For generating appropriate FGDC metadata and uploading image data (in the required format) to the Division of Geographic Information for free public distribution via their website.
- ii. For generating appropriate metadata for in-house imagery and making it freely available to the public in user-friendly formats (e.g., GEOTIFF, JPEG, etc.) hosted on the Member's own website.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Applications will be accepted on an ongoing basis until **November 1, 2009**

Funded activities/projects which do not use funding for the approved purpose stated in their applications will be required to reimburse KentuckyView for the full award amount.

A) STIPENDS

For PROPOSED activities or purchases, please submit the following items:

- i. A reasonably detailed (up to) one page summary of the proposed activity or purchase, including a timeline if applicable
- ii. A current 1-2 page CV

For already COMPLETED activities, please submit the following items:

- i. A reasonably detailed one page summary of the completed activity
- ii. A current 1-2 page CV
- iii. At least one of the following items: evaluations, photographs, testimonials, fact sheets

B) PROJECTS

Please submit the following items:

- i. A reasonably detailed 1-2 page description of the proposed project, including a timeline
- ii. References, figures, tables, data sheets, etc. (as appropriate to the project) do not count towards the 1-2 page limit
- iii. A current 1-2 page CV
- iv. A reasonably detailed budget with justification

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

All final reports and, if required, budget reports are due no later than **December 18, 2009**.

NOTE: Funded activities/projects must provide KentuckyView with a copy of any data purchased with KentuckyView funds (if permitted by copyright, licensing, etc.).

A) STIPENDS

Once proposed activities (but not purchases) have been completed, please submit the following items:

- i. A reasonably detailed one page summary of the completed activity.
- ii. At least one of the following items: evaluations, photographs, testimonials, fact sheets.

B) PROJECTS

Once projects have been completed, please submit the following items:

- i. A reasonably detailed 2-3 page summary of the completed project
- ii. A final budget report detailing all project expenditures, as well as unspent funds
- iii. For Education and Applied Research projects only..... at least one of the following items:
evaluations, photographs, testimonials, fact sheets.
